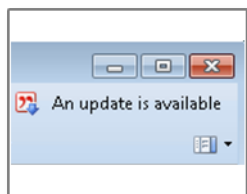

### Free Update for Citavi 3.1 Now Available



We're very excited about all of the improvements in Citavi 3.1. Here are a few highlights: you can now collaborate with colleagues on Citavi projects, the Picker supports Firefox 5 and Internet Explorer 9, and compilations now include a table of contents.

How can you update to Citavi 3.1? When you open a Citavi project, Citavi will let you know that an update is available (as long as you're connected to the internet). Click *An update is available* and follow the steps in the setup assistant. Alternatively, you can download the most recent version of Citavi at [www.citavi.com/download](http://www.citavi.com/download).

### Collaborate in a Team



It's what you've been waiting for: the ability to collaborate on Citavi projects with others. With Citavi 3.1 we've made your wish a reality. Just save a Citavi project on a shared network and invite colleagues to work on it with you.

The team functions you are able to use depend on your license. With a *Citavi Pro* license you can work on team projects containing up to 100 references, and you can view team projects with more than 100 references. A license for *Citavi Team* allows you to work on all projects, even those containing more than 100 references. The Citavi Reader lets you view team projects with more than 100 references.

If your organization has purchased a site license for Citavi, you may even be able to obtain a license key for Citavi Team at no cost. ### Pickers are Back for Firefox 5 and Internet Explorer 9



A Picker is now available for Firefox 5 (and the upcoming versions Firefox 6 and Firefox 7). In the future you won't need to install an update for every new Firefox version that comes along, since the Firefox Picker will be released as a separate program – and will then be compatible with Firefox Portable as well. Citavi 3.1 also includes a Picker for Internet Explorer 9 (but not for the 64-bit version).

### Many More Improvements in Citavi 3.1

The compilation feature allows you to create a structured list of your collected quotations and thoughts with their corresponding bibliography entries. With Citavi 3.1 a table of contents is now placed at the beginning of this document.

Citavi now includes an add-on interface which will make it easier to customize special requests.

And there's more: BibTeX users can now export to BibLateX. Also, if you're performing a search on the website ArXiv.org, you can easily add your results to Citavi using the Picker.
